Dear Mayor and Council,

Following last week's Council discussion pertaining to the CAC policy report, staff received a request from a Councillor to provide a list of all rental projects (in last 5 years or so) that have gotten DCL waivers, ie. Rental 100, STIR, etc. Please see the following response and two attachments –

- PDS reports out annually on the DCL revenues and collections. The most recent report was for 2018 and was published this past fall. Staff have also prepared a map illustrating the uptake of DCL waivers /reductions over this period as well.
- Accordingly, please see attached showing location of all rental projects that have taken the DCL waiver from 2010 to 2018. A total of 36 projects took the DCL Waiver over that period, representing 3702 rental units. The DCL waiver value over that period was \$23,946,616.
- For further information, please see the 2018 Annual Report on Development Cost Levies which lists the secured market rental project that received a waiver by address and year from 2010-2018 on page 18 (see table attached for convenience). The 2019 Annual Report on DCLs will be published later this calendar year.
