Good afternoon Council,

As an update to Sadhu's note last night, our staff were on site this morning with the contractor, the owner's engineer, a geotechnical engineer and WorkSafeBC. The geotech has provided a plan to remediate the collapse and equipment is on site to undertake the work. Essentially, the excavation will be filled in to stabilize the wall.

The adjacent building (Congee House Restaurant) is currently unsafe to occupy. Our team is in contact with the owner.

At this point, the matter is in hand and the work is proceeding well. If you have any questions or concerns, please let me know.
