Subject: Signage on the future Olympic Village school site - RTS 13418

Dear Mayor and Council,

At the meeting on Sept 10, 2019, a Councillor requested clarifying information and to install signage on the future Olympic Village school site (RTS 013418) and staff have provided the response below –

REFM and PDS have considered the possibility of installing a sign on the future elementary school site in South East False Creek to notify the public of the intended use of the site. COV staff discussed this issue with VSB and confirmed that VSB has not yet been able to commit funding towards the construction of the school, and the timing of the delivery of the school is therefore uncertain. As such, COV and VSB staff recommend to not install a sign on the site until there is more certainty of funding and a schedule for the design and construction of the school. More information on efforts by COV and VSB to enable timely construction or renovation of schools, including the new school in SEFC, will be provided in a separate report or memo to Council this spring (please refer to RTS 013459/013562).
