Subject: Upcoming MA - Next Steps for Ride-Hailing

Dear Mayor and Council,

On February 25, City staff will be presenting Council with proposed updates for an interim intermunicipal business licence for ride-hailing, which will be the only business licence that ride hailing companies will require to operate in participating municipalities in Region 1 (Hope to Whistler). If approved by Council, the City would administer the licensing for all municipalities.

We plan to hold a media tech briefing on Wednesday, February 19, where City staff will explain the new licensing program to members of the media and help clarify any questions they may have. No recording for broadcast will be permitted during this session and media will be referred to Mayor or Council for comment or an interview.
