SUBJECT: Transit Service Additions to East Fraser Lands

On April 6, 2020 TransLink will launch the first of two new routes to East Fraser Lands (EFL): Route 31 from EFL to Metrotown. In early March, TransLink will publically announce that the route will run a 24-person capacity 'shuttle' bus every 30-35 minutes from 6AM to 10PM on weekdays, 7AM to 10PM on Saturdays, and 8AM to 10PM on Sundays and Holidays. See Appendix A for routing details.

The second new route, Route 80, is expected to be delivered by the end of 2021 and will provide limited-stop weekday peak period service from EFL to Marine Drive Station on the Canada Line. Both of these routes are made possible by funds allocated in TransLink's Phase 2 Investment Plan (approved 2018).

These two new bus routes are the result of ongoing collaboration between TransLink and City staff to explore improved transit service options to EFL and other neighbourhoods in the southeast portion of the City within the budget envelope currently available. In the longer term, it is desired to have more frequent service and more service options in this area. TransLink has indicated that they will continue to explore transit service redesign opportunities to better connect Fraserview, Champlain Heights, EFL and the Expo Line in the future; however, any service extensions costing additional resources to operate would require new funding to be approved, and so this would be in the medium to long-term.

More broadly, TransLink and the City have committed to collaborating on an update to TransLink's Vancouver/UBC Area Transportation Plan. The process is expected to be completed by the end of 2023, timed to support transit network redesign after the Broadway



Subway opens. Staff at both organizations will be looking closely at transit service design across the City, including the southeast. The City will also examine where transit supportive infrastructure, such as sidewalks and bus stops, is required and how this infrastructure can be delivered.
