Dear Mayor and Council,

On behalf of our Sustainability Team, I'm reaching out with a special ask to help influence climate policy in Vancouver.

The City recently launched public engagement on its [Climate Emergency Action Plan](#). Between now and April 22, we're seeking input on 19 bold actions to drastically reduce carbon pollution in Vancouver over the next five years, as action while planning under the Vancouver Plan.

We need as many Vancouverites as possible to tell us what they think of the actions so that we can develop a plan that works for everyone.

To help expand our reach, we've created [Dialogue Kits](#) to help people hold conversations about the plan and send us the results. The kits include instructions, tips, and prompts to make hosting easy, and the City will use the results to shape our plan. These kits are also a key complement to the Vancouver Plan Dialogue Kits being released this week.

I'm asking if you'd be interested in hosting a dialogue with your network before April 22. Hosts don't need to be subject-matter experts and your group can vary from 2-8 people, or more. If you've got a captive audience and 1 to 2 hours, you can make a significant contribution to our climate efforts.
