Subject:	COVID-19 - updated public health direction for BC

Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

Dr. Bonnie Henry and Minister Dix are currently holding their daily media event regarding the COVID-19 outbreak. Dr. Henry has announced a significant shift in BC's approach to prevent community transmission and contain the outbreak. The key points as noted from her live comments are as follows:

- Residents should avoid all non-essential travel outside Canada, including US. All returning travelers will be required to self-isolate for 14 days.
- □ Mass gatherings Icancel all events over 250 people.
- □ Increase distancing in workplaces □avoid meetings, work from home.
- BC is not closing schools, at this point.

These directions have significant implications for Vancouver and our operations. We were anticipating a material change in direction today and are now reviewing these impacts in detail and planning our response accordingly. We will keep you apprised as we have additional information.
