Subject: PM press conference this morning

Good Morning:

Here's a summary of Prime Minister's morning briefing from our IGR team:

- House of Commons re-convenes today to pass emergency legislation which will introduce a bill to spend up to \$82 billion and increase federal powers. This is only the beginning.
- There will be more support and more information in the coming days. Nothing is off the table.
- The Federal Emergencies Act is considered to be a last resort at this point but if people don't follow the health guidelines then the government will put more stringent measures in place.
- There are challenges and backlogs with testing (this was discussed with Premiers last night on a First Ministers' Call), the government is increasing the number of tests by 10s of thousands each day.
