Subject: Update: Corduroy Lounge licence suspension

Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

As you may recall, the business licence for the above-referenced establishment was suspended by the Chief Licence Inspector until December 31, 2021. That decision was taken in conjunction with the suspension of the restaurant's permit to operate by VCH.

VCH has now approved an amended permit to operate that allows for take-out service only. Accordingly, the business licence suspension has been amended to expire at the end of day today, November 15th.

The location will continue to work with Vancouver Coastal Health for any further changes to their operations including counter service or full dine-in service. As Corduroy will have an issued licence, no further clearance will be required for the business licence should they be approved to increase their service options.
