Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

As you may be aware, the weather forecast for the coming days is indicating the potential for snow. The current forecast calls for rain/snow mix late Friday night into Saturday morning with no accumulations expected. The longer range forecast suggests another freeze on Saturday night/Sunday morning; and a greater potential for accumulating snow that starts on Sunday night and tapers off on midday Monday.

Despite the likelihood that roadways will not be affected by the snow tonight and tomorrow, Engineering has staff scheduled as a precautionary measure to monitor conditions and apply brine/salt. We will continue to adjust our response plans as/when the conditions change.
