Subject: 1046 Granville SRO - Heating Issue Resolved

Hi Council,

Councillor Kirby-Yung has been inquiring about the SRO at 1046 Granville, which was said to have been without heat for the past three days.

The issue has been resolved; here is an update:

The City was made aware of the issue of no heat at 1046 Granville at approximately 11:30 AM today (Dec 27th). City staff connected with the building's onsite manager, who confirmed a fuse had blown that has since been reset/repared and that the power and heat had been restored. The City has received no further inquiries at this point, but will check in with the operator again in the morning.

In addition, this morning, all private SRO operators were contacted by the City's Supportive Housing & SROs team regarding important safety-related information related to current cold temperatures, fire risk and building electrical systems, and suggested appropriate actions to take in the event of blown fuses or localized outages.
