RE: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of May 14, 2021 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Records regarding political representation and diversity, specifically: visible minority numbers in the 1990s and 1980s in the City of Vancouver.

Based on your response to our clarification letter* sent to you on May 19, 2021 we have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located.

*We understand you mean City of Vancouver as an organization and the number of people from racialized communities (visible minorities) within the population.

The City of Vancouver does not currently, nor has it historically, conducted a municipal census or other official information gathering survey regarding the ethnic identity of City of Vancouver citizens.

We suggest you check the Federal Census data available from Statistics Canada.
