Thank you for taking the time to share your concerns with the City of Vancouver regarding the RV?s on Slocan Street near Vancouver Technical Secondary

School. 

During the Strathcona Park decampment process, staff began providing notices to other on street RV encampments within the City to ensure consistent messaging and to minimize the risk of people moving from Strathcona Park to these encampments as seen with the Vernon Drive location. All notices included contact information for Carnegie Outreach and enforcement was delayed for those who were working with Outreach and 311 to request tow support to an off-street location of the occupant?s choosing.

The City has prioritized work on Slocan Street due to the on-street material issues and increasing public complaints. Parking, Outreach, and Sanitation teams met last week to discuss the approach to this site and Outreach teams will be attending to Slocan Street this week. Outreach will be working to connect RV residents with housing options prior to bylaw enforcement. Once Outreach attends to the site, the City will be in a position to issue a final warning notice before enforcement. &#x0D:

Through the work at Strathcona Park, the City has had more success than the past with RV occupants contacting and working with Outreach teams. In some locations. there will also be signage installed to inform parking restrictions for ?oversized vehicles? (RV?s).

Thank you again for your feedback; your concerns have been received by the Mayor and Councillors.

Like many cities along the West Coast, Vancouver continues to see a growing number of large vehicles, such as RVs and campers, parked illegally on local streets. Prior to COVID-19, the City followed a two-step warning process before starting any enforcement. However, given the pandemic and the guidance received from the Provincial Health Officer to minimize displacement, the City has been taking a measured approach to illegally parked large vehicles on City streets. Over the last seven months, the City has been actively monitoring a number of hotspots to manage the negative impact and address complaints from residents, businesses and a high school regarding the accumulation of garbage and other debris, noise, human waste and lack of available parking for students and activities that use school property. Parking Enforcement has also been following an extended enforcement timeline. Unlike other violations (e.g., expired parking meter and no stopping zone), enforcement of illegally parked RVs starts with warning notices and educating vehicles owners/occupants about the City?s parking by-laws. &#x0D:

Not all RVs parked on city streets have people living in them. Abandoned RVs are a potential safety hazard due to the flammable propane tanks left behind. However, for those who are living in parked RVs, they do so for different reasons ? not all people consider themselves homeless or at risk of being homeless. The City?s Homelessness Services Outreach team is committed working with those who require assistance by connecting these individuals to housing, income or other  $% \left\{ 1,2,...,n\right\}$ supports.
