Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of June 15, 2021 for:

The following records regarding City Emergency Parking Program – Survey and the statement under the "Why" section: "Burning gas and diesel in vehicles is a major contributor to climate change – accounting for 40% of carbon pollution in Vancouver":

- 1. Reference to the above statement;
- 2. Breakdown of the above statement that shows what percentage of Vancouver residential vehicles are contributing to carbon pollution vs. other sources which may include non-Vancouver residential vehicles from other municipalities, commercial trucks, etc.

This information is publicly available on the City of Vancouver's website at the link below and is from the community emissions inventory, which is updated and published annually.

Hover or click your curser on the line graph under "Progress we've made so far" which will show the emissions breakdown per year.

Note, the City does not track resident and non-resident emissions; however, you can see a breakdown between light duty and medium/heavy duty vehicles.
