Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of July 9, 2021 for:

The following records regarding parking regulation changes at 800 West 12th Avenue (across the main entrance from VGH):

- 1. The parking regulation that existed prior to the sign being changed on or before July 4, 2021;**
- 2. The year that this earlier parking regulation began and length of time it had been in effect;**
- 3. The date the sign (parking regulation) changed; and**
- 4. Why there was no clear indication that a long standing parking regulation had changed.**

All responsive records are attached.

For point two of your request, the Engineering department advised there are no records indicating the start date or length of time the previous parking regulation had been in effect.

For point three of your request, the Engineering Department confirms that the sign regulation was changed on July 3, 2021.

Under section 52 of the Act, and within 30 business days of receipt of this letter, you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your FOI request by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc.bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.

If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number (#04-1000-20-2021-367); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request; and 4) detailed reasons why you are seeking the review.

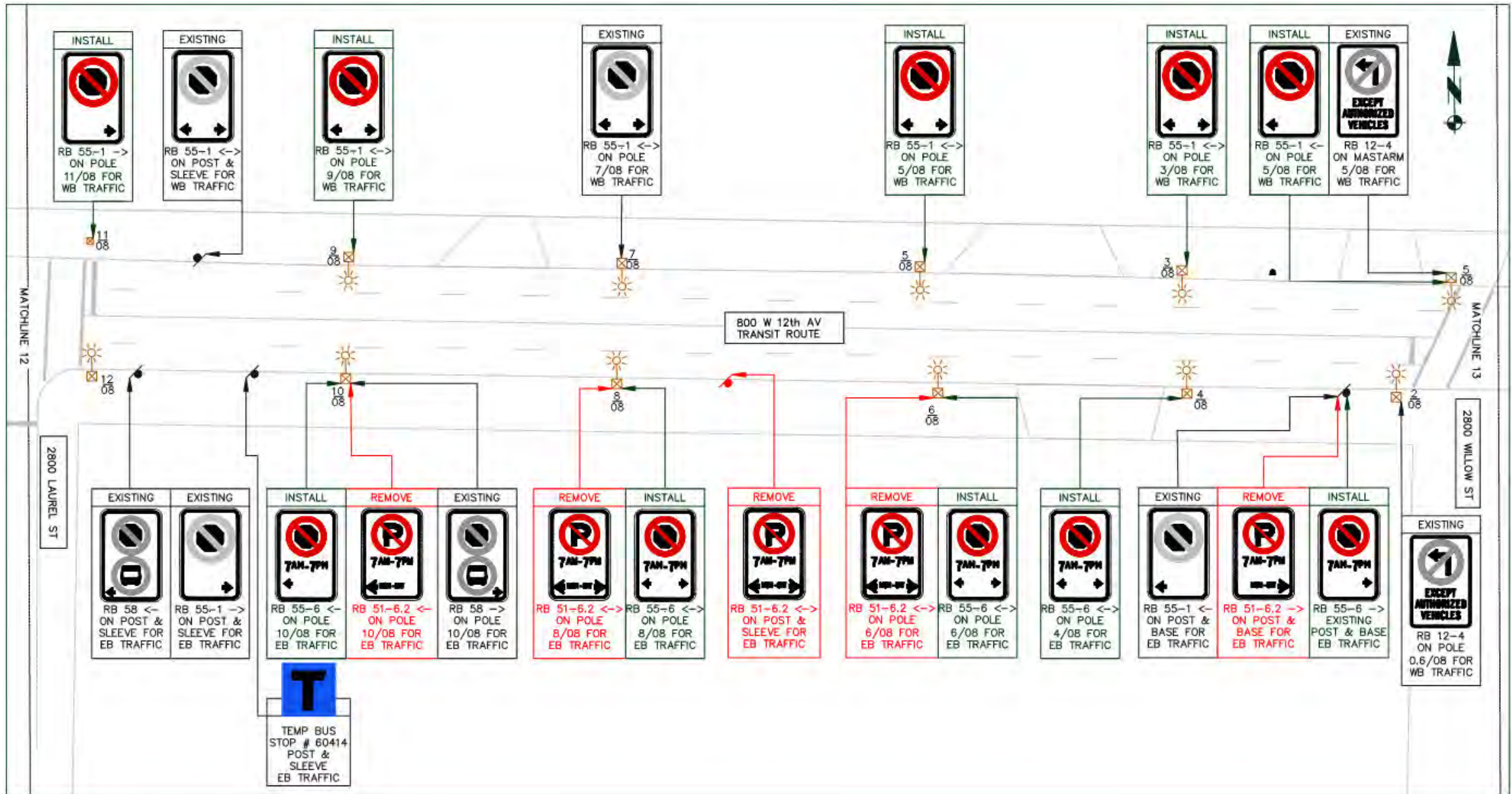

RE: Parking Regulation Changes on W 12th Avenue

The City of Vancouver is changing parking regulations along W 12th Avenue in order to support relocated trolley buses and improve traffic flow in advance of the nearby Broadway Subway construction. The changes will speed up travel times for buses while minimizing impact to general traffic.

The parking regulation changes will be implemented in February 2021 and details are follows:
