Dear Mayor and Council,

Through 2022, Statistics Canada will be releasing seven major data sets from the 2021 Census Count, which took place on May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The Census release schedule for 2022 is available through Statistics Canada at: <https://www12.statcan.gc.ca/census-recensement/2021/ref/prodserv/release-diffusion-eng.cfm>. The last Census Survey was completed May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and this Wednesday, February 9<sup>th</sup>, Statistics Canada will be releasing the first in a series of seven major data sets, starting with Total Population, Total Dwellings and Total Occupied Dwellings. Data points commonly used by the City related to Dwelling Types; Average Persons Per Household; and the detailed analysis of Unoccupied Dwellings are part of subsequent data releases or custom data requests made by the City of Vancouver and will not be available from Statistics Canada until later in 2022 or early 2023.

Staff will be preparing a memo to council following each of the seven major Census releases and will be monitoring, Statistics Canada's release of additional themes and key findings, updated data tables and analysis as this information is made available.
