Dear Mayor and Council,

Staff are launching important public engagement sessions later this week. The following email is a brief summary and overview of this work, including next steps.

Regulation Redesign Update and Upcoming Engagement

Regulation Redesign is a project to simplify and clarify the City's land use regulations and related documents to reduce complexity and support work to streamline permit processing. The current round of work includes preparation of an updated and fully reformatted Zoning and Development By-law to improve document navigation and accessibility, and clarify and consolidate land use regulations.

The work is informed by consultation with public, industry and staff. There are upcoming opportunities for individuals and groups to provide input on the proposed directions including:

- Public engagement through Shape Your City ☞April 22 to May 6
- Public information session on April 27
- Office Hours for public to contact staff with questions
- Information sessions with BOMA, HAVAN, and UDI
- Staff consultation including a lunch and learn and targeted information sessions.

Key Council milestones include:

- Council briefing ☞May 9
- Council referral report ☞June
- Public Hearing ☞July
