Dear Mayor and Council,

Following up on the memo I sent you on April 21, 2022 concerning tomorrow's Special Council Meeting on public safety and violent crime, we are going to be slightly changing the format/agenda.

Rather than separating speakers into a group of guest presentations and then general speaker delegations (as previously indicated), we are going to have all speakers present to Council as speaker delegations. This better aligns with standard Council practice, and will give Council the opportunity to ask questions of each speaker through the regular process, without having to suspend any of the regular *Procedure Bylaw* rules.

The City Clerk's Office will be letting the group formerly categorised as guest speakers know, and this change does not affect their allotted time to speak.

We'd like to remind Council that the speaker's list is still open, and people can register until the deadline, **Thursday, April 28th @ 5 pm.**
