Dear Mayor and Council,

On Tuesday evening, Council will be considering a rezoning application for the Heather Lands. The Heather Lands site is currently co-owned by Canada Lands Company (CLC) and the Musqueam Indian Band, Squamish Nation and Tsleil-Waututh Nations in partnership (collectively the MST Nations).

The Public Hearing represents a significant milestone in the planning for these lands which commenced in October 2018. Given the importance of this project to the MST Nations, Chief Wayne Sparrow from the Musqueam Indian Band and Senior representatives from Squamish Nation and Tsleil-Waututh Nation are planning to attend the Public Hearing, in person, to address members of Council. As such, Chief Sparrow respectfully requests that members of Council also attend the meeting in Council Chambers.

If in person attendance is limited, Chief Sparrow will call into the meeting. He is hoping that staff can advise on Council attendance so that he and the other Nations representatives can plan accordingly.
