Good morning Mayor and Council,

On behalf of Chief Fry, I am writing to advise that VFRS crews responded to a major fire at the Value Village at 1820 East Hastings St yesterday evening. The call was received shortly after 10:00pm and was quickly upgraded to a 3<sup>rd</sup> alarm.

The building has collapsed and is a total loss. The fire also spread to an adjoining car lot.

A multi-unit residential building immediately to the south of the Value Village property was evacuated and sustained significant contamination due to smoke. Our Emergency Social Services team responded and 22 residents were provided with short-term hotel accommodations, transportation to the hotel and food vouchers. We are awaiting further indication regarding the timeline for those residents to return to their units; hotel availability is very limited over the long weekend.

There were no reported injuries.
