I understand that you may be receiving questions from members of the public regarding services for individuals sheltering outdoors, given the very cold temperatures forecast for the next 48-72 hours. I can confirm that we have two warming centres open in the DTES tonight (Aboriginal Front Door at 390 Main across the street from Carnegie Community Centre and Powell St Getaway at 450 E Hastings). There are also warming centres activated in Fairview, Downtown, Mt Pleasant and Marpole. All 5 of the extreme weather shelters in Vancouver (approx. 100 spaces) are open as well.

First responders are also monitoring closely for individuals at risk due to exposure.
