See below some questions I have:

- s.14, s.17(1), s.21(1) , there is an opportunity to advance the preparation at the site. Given the use of water filled barriers, how soon can VP install the barriers and fencing with the safety protocols agreed in place? We can install the barriers with +/- 1 week notice to coordinate. If we have certainty on the start date, we can confirm with the insurer that installing 2-3 weeks in advance of work starting is acceptable.
- How much lead time does VP need to mobilize and start the actual deconstruction work? We will need two weeks to mobilize resources.
- What is the ballpark cost to dismantle and remove the barge? Our current estimate is +/-\$2.4M
- Is the deconstruction work still slated to take 12-15 weeks? Yes, current duration is anticipated to be 12-15 weeks, however we will try to accelerate once onsite.

Hi lan,

Thanks for the first draft of the expanded sketch, much appreciated. Please see below some edits requested by the CoV and PB Land Survey teams:

- Remove the magenta line (additional area sought)
- Remove green area top of bank (permanent park) to be consistent with the area to the north that is also owned by City and not leased and so not represented with any linework.
- All legal lots identified are reflected, but in some instances need to be made clearer by adding plan numbers and labelling district lots (DLs rather than lots). There should be <u>plan</u> <u>numbers</u> with all the lot numbers. Otherwise, the parcel designations are not unique:
 - Technically, what are labeled Lots 5322, 5321, 5320, 5319, and 7811 are district lots . These should be <u>labelled DL 5322", etc...</u> A note could go in the legend: "DL indicates District Lot"
 - Should label Lot A, Plan 20533 to the north. The barge primarily lies in this lot.
 - Should label Lot D, Plan 20799 to northeast (top of bank permanent park).
 - <u>DL 5322 extends into Lot A</u> to the north this should be reflected in the sketch, along with boundary with DL 5323.
 - Show boundary between DL 5323 and DL 185.

Remove the magenta line (additional area sought)

- Remove green area top of bank (permanent park) to be consistent with the area to the north that is also owned by City and not leased and so not represented with any linework.
- All legal lots identified are reflected, but in some instances need to be made clearer by adding plan numbers and labelling district lots (DLs rather than lots). There should be <u>plan</u> <u>numbers</u> with all the lot numbers. Otherwise, the parcel designations are not unique:
 - Technically, what are labeled Lots 5322, 5321, 5320, 5319, and 7811 are district lots . These should be <u>labelled DL 5322", etc...</u> A note could go in the legend: "DL indicates District Lot"
 - Should label Lot A, Plan 20533 to the north. The barge primarily lies in this lot.
 - Should label Lot D, Plan 20799 to northeast (top of bank permanent park).
 - <u>DL 5322 extends into Lot A</u> to the north this should be reflected in the sketch, along with boundary with DL 5323.
 - Show boundary between DL 5323 and DL 185.

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more to report on these in the next few days.

Reviewing the EXP memo, I note that a structural assessment is specifically excluded from the memo's scope of work. Also, the memo recommends that the "stability" of our sewer be reviewed and confirmed. We need to rely on the proponent to provide such review and confirmation as needed to support the proposed work near our existing infrastructure. Also, the memo refers to an axle load that is specified in the record drawings, but I did not find such an axle load in the record drawings that were attached.

I understand that the haul route that is proposed for bringing in the concrete barriers is from the far side of our Jervis Pump Station. Per our mapping, the haul route would pass over the pump station's discharge forcemains and the downstream end of the WEI2 (please see the map image below). We need to include these crossings in the review of the proposed work. Also, the haul route would cross a Greater Vancouver Water District watermain. A separate consent is likely needed from the Water District for this proposed work. If not done so already, a submission to our Construct Review inbox (constructreview@metrovancouver.org

During our meeting, I recall there was some mention of possibly using plastic barriers that can be filled with water, in place of the proposed concrete barriers. Would this be a viable option? The

empty barriers would be much lighter and would avoid many of the loading issues that we are dealing with. And presumably the water can be piped in from possibly a hydrant so a water truck would not be needed.
