I hope this finds you well.\~ I am writing with respect to the Olympic Athletes' Village site for the 2030 Winter Games.

As we understand it, the COC is planning to publicly announce that the Jericho Lands is the intended location for the 2030 OAV. We understand this is the COC's and Leadership Assembly's decision, however we want to convey that we strongly believe that it would be premature and potentially detrimental to the long-term success of the Jericho development to make this announcement next week.\~

While we believe that the Jericho Lands site for the 2030 OAV is possible, there are some significant constraints that centre around very challenging and critical construction delivery timelines. The COC and the OAV Working Group are aware of these issues, which center around;

1~

- 1. Interpreted The strong possibility that archeological findings will slow down construction timelines.
- 2.1-1-1-1- The fact that these lands are very under-serviced with respect to City utilities such as water and sewerage, and that the timing of providing this servicing vis-à-vis 2030 is likely an issue.
- 3. Internation The fact that the UBCx Broadway Subway Extension is in all likelihood not

going to be in service by 2030, creating transit/transportation challenges for this site.

Also, more importantly, it is our strong view that a public announcement next week will likely have serious ramifications regarding the long-term success of the development, in particular, with respect to implications for the ongoing and sensitive community dialogue around the Jericho development project. There has been no public discourse on the Jericho Lands development since December 2021, and we anticipate that an unexpected announcement will cause substantial public reaction.

Given the above and subject to the agreement of the First Nations decision-makers involved, we suggest that the COC announcement next week, makes reference that the OAV will be sited on First Nations lands in Vancouver, however, with the specific location to be determined.
