Key Messages – Services Agreement

- The City and the Squamish have signed a symbolic Services Agreement, in response to the Squamish Nation's request to provide municipal services that are needed to support the M^ʌg^ʌkw Development.
- The Agreement will guide the government-to-government relationship between the City of Vancouver and the Squamish Nation regarding the provision of municipal services, amenities and infrastructure for residents and businesses in the M^ʌg^ʌkw neighbourhood going forward.
- The last details of the Services Agreement are being worked out, and we expect it to be finalized in early June. At that time, the City will make the details of the agreement public.
- Under the terms of the Agreement, the City will deliver a range of municipal services to the M^ʌg^ʌkw neighbourhood such as fire, police, utilities, public works and library services, and the Squamish Nation will pay for these services at the same rates as property owners in Vancouver. The Nation will also be providing a contribution to the city to offset the addition of the development on amenities and infrastructure.
- The Agreement has been structured to ensure that the City is appropriately compensated for the municipal services it will provide, and that future residents and businesses in M^ʌg^ʌkw will receive the same level of service as Vancouver residents to ensure this neighbourhood is livable, safe and sustainable for years to come.
