Annex A.

Below are the conditions for the movement of regulated articles from within the area described in Schedule 1 of *Japanese Beetle infested place order for the cities of Vancouver and Burnaby in the province of British Columbia* and *Schedule II of the Plant Protection Regulations*, to an area outside of this area.

A log must be kept of all movements that are allowed under the associated movement certificate (log template provided by the CFIA).

For soil originating within the top 30 cm of the surface and not beneath an impermeable surface, and/or plant parts with soil (year-round):

- All regulated articles being transported outside of the regulated area must be secured and safeguarded within the conveyance to prevent the escape of Japanese Beetle.
- The conveyance must proceed directly to the Metro Vancouver Landfill at 5400 72 St, Delta, BC V4K 3N3, where all the regulated articles must be unloaded for deep burial.
- At the landfill, the conveyance must be carefully emptied and swept, where possible, so as to remove all regulated articles for deep burial.
- All equipment, tools and articles of clothing exiting the regulated area that have come into contact with regulated articles must be cleaned free of regulated articles at the landfill site before leaving.

For above-ground plant parts extracted from an outdoor source (i.e. grass clippings, pruning waste and branches with leaves) between June 15 and October 15:

- All above conditions apply or dispose of material as per table below.

- Additionally, pruning waste and branches must be shaken before loading into the conveyance destined for the approved disposal location to help remove adult Japanese Beetles. **Shake... Load... and Cover!**

Regulated Materials

1. "soil" means the loose surface of the earth in which plants grow, in most cases consisting of disintegrated rock with an admixture of organic matter, including related matter such as clay, silt, sand, soil minerals, humus, compost, earthworm castings, muck, plant litter and debris, either individually or in combination
2. "above ground plant parts" includes grass clippings, pruning waste and branches with leaves attached
3. "plant parts with soil" includes turgrass, sod, ornamental grasses and other outdoor plants with soil
4. "soil, top 30cm" means the exposed soil that is not covered by an impermeable surface
5. "soil below 30cm, or under an impermeable surface" includes soil under concrete, asphalt or an existing building footprint
6. "deep burial" means material must be taken the Vancouver Landfill and buried at least 2m
