Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of September 22, 2022 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act)* for:

- 1. Total annual number of By-law infractions/tickets issued for: a) panhandling and b) selling/conducting business without a licence; and
- 2. Total annual number of Business Licences issued in the Downtown Eastside for: a) collecting/selling recyclable bottles/cans and b) selling wares on the sidewalks.

Date Range: January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2021.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located. The Property Use Inspection department confirmed that they are unable to determine how many tickets were issued for alleged business licencing violations, and further stated that they are unable to generate data specific to individual neighbourhoods. Furthermore the department added that violations do not always result in formal enforcement; the first step is to promote voluntary compliance, and failing that there is the option of issuing a letter, order, and/or a ticket.

With regards to your inquiry relating to panhandling in point one, the Vancouver Police Department is responsible for issuing tickets under s.70A (Obstructive Solicitation) of the Street and Traffic By-law no. 2849 (<u>https://bylaws.vancouver.ca/2849c.PDF</u>), which includes panhandling. You may contact the VPD directly to request this information, as they are a separate public body under the Act. In regards to point two, the Licence Office has confirmed that there are no business licence categories specific to the two activities requested, therefore there are no responsive records.
