Attached is the NFA data as of April 2021 for Vancouver and Burnaby with the following caveats:

- □ ~~~ NFA is not an indicator of homelessness and would not correlate to homelessness counts. Some staff use NFA when a client is moving from one address to another but don have that address yet.
- Dates: The NFA data is a snapshot in time (April 2021). We do not currently have a means to go back historically to get these numbers, nor the ability to see any trends at a contact level. SDPR is working on that with ISD but it is not currently available.

I was informed that the additional data you requested would require a formal FOI request: $\$

- Indigeneity or any racial indicators
- Length of time registered as NFA (e.g. <6 months, <1 yr, etc.)
- Length of time receiving income assistance
- Registered address at shelter, residing with friends/family, etc.
- · Duration of time living in BC
- Number of new applications in the last 12 months (compared to the March date extracted in the previous year).
 - If possible, also cross-referencing with length of time living in BC and previous province lived in.

However, with regard to Indigeneity or any racial indicators Indigeneity is self identifiable and not a required field in our system, for that reason we have not provided it in the past. Racial indicators are not collected. The closest we collect is sponsorship but that does not equal race.

The remaining fields would likely require an FOI request as well based on the time required to join the data sets together and in some cases, the SDPR system does not collect the fields but may be available through manual effort.

Once again, thank you for your patience. Now that a process has been established I do not think the wait will be as long next time.
