The Vancouver Heritage Register (VHR), is an official listing of properties identified as having heritage value or character. The VHR, adopted in 1986, primarily reflects colonial, settler-oriented narratives of history, and does not reflect the broad and diverse range of the city's heritage values.

In 2020, Council adopted the Vancouver Heritage Program with its vision, goals and direction. The purpose of this work is to upgrade the VHR to more closely reflect the Vancouver Heritage Program, to be able to identify, embrace, and celebrate a broad range of places with social, cultural and historic values, based on principles of reconciliation, diversity and equity. Staff will present an overview of the Vancouver Heritage Register, project timelines and draft guiding principles for feedback and comment.
