Good morning Mayor and Council,

I expect you have seen the sad news over the past 24 hours regarding the death of Gino Odjick. Staff have been asked about lowering flags at City Hall and other CoV facilities to half-mast in commemoration of Mr. Odjick's life as a prominent and much-beloved Vancouver resident.

Under the City's flag policy, Council has the prerogative to lower flags to half-mast to honour any person or event. As we have done in similar instances in the past, I am writing to advise Council of this request and solicit any questions or concerns. Subject to any objections, we will proceed with lowering flags to half-mast sometime after noon today and communicating same.
