On behalf of Sport Hosting Vancouver, we would like to invite you and a guest to attend the **2023 HSBC Canada Sevens** on March 3rd, 4th or 5th, 2023, at BC Place Stadium in Vancouver, BC.

This year marks the 8th edition of this World Rugby Sevens Tour taking place in Vancouver. Sevens rugby is a fast-paced and shorter version of traditional rugby with only seven players per side playing 7-minute halves. HSBC Canada Sevens 2023 will be the first time ever Canada has hosted the Worlds top Womens and Men's Sevens teams including Olympic Champions New Zealand (Women's) and Fiji (Men's), and Rugby World Cup Champions Australia (Women's) and Fiji (Men's).
