On Tuesday March 21, a private event will be held to celebrate the opening of Vancouver's first-ever Tiny Shelter pilot project. [For more information about the project, please review the NR issued in 2022.](#)

The Tiny Shelters project provides vital shelter space to couples experiencing homelessness, an underserved group of people, including people who may not do well in a congregate setting. The project will be operated by Lu'ma who will also offer support services including showers, laundry, and community programming.
