Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

Please find below an update from General Manager of ACCS Sandra Singh on the DTES Market relocation:

- Staff in ACCS have been working to identify a site for the DTES Market for some time.
- The lease on the current temporary site for the Market expires at the end of August.
- An opportunity at 123 E Hastings had arisen and ACCS and REF M were working on a plan to activate that site for the market should demolition of the existing building be approved through the City's various regulatory processes.
- New information has been shared with GM, ACCS Sandra Singh and her staff that make the site operationally unviable so they will be ceasing to work on this deployment.
- She and her team will be working with community stakeholders, VPD, and other City Departments as needed to identify any other options for street vending in the DTES.
