Good evening Mayor and Council,

I am sending this Q&A response in advance of the Weekly Q&As as the information is related to tomorrow's consideration of the proposed Council Strategic Priorities, 2023-2026.

Regarding the Better Together Pilot Project, we were asked about the engagement of residents in one of the pilot neighbourhoods, Downtown South:

## Vacancies outstanding if any:

- · As of Oct 30th, we have only received one application for the DT South Resident Round Table
- The Mount Pleasant and Olympic Village resident tables are active, with a total of 17 residents attending regularly.

## Recruitment efforts to date if applicable:

- For the DT South, in addition to previous efforts to solicit applications there was targeted Social media in September and October.
- Staff will continue to work with Communications team to solicit interest in participation until the end of the pilot in March 2024.

## How many meetings have taken place, format, outcomes, etc:

- Due to lack of applications, no meetings have taken place for the DT South Resident Round Table.
  There have been six agency roundtable meetings in DT South; these have been virtual meetings to support attendance.
- There have been eight meetings in Mt. Pleasant, and ten meetings in Olympic Village of the resident tables.
  - · These have all been in person, in the evenings.
  - · Each of these meetings have been well attended.
  - Members report joining to contribute to their community and report feeling more connected after meetings

Please note the Better Together Pilot ends in 5 months in March 2024. Staff will provide a summary of the evaluation findings and any recommendations for future consideration in early summer 2024.
