As an elected official, you are invited to stand in the canopied area at the top of the south steps. Please note that there is no seating under the canopy. If you require seating, you may check in with a volunteer by 9:45 am to request a seat in the guest seating area.

#### Remembrance Day Ceremonies:

I would also like to advise of other Remembrance Day ceremonies taking place across Vancouver. Members of Council have been assigned to place a wreath at each of these ceremonies according to the Deputy Mayor and Duty Councillor roster.

Wreaths have been ordered and delivery arrangements have been made. All of the City of Vancouver official wreaths will be delivered to the event sites listed below, except for the wreath for the Japanese Canadian War Memorial, which will be delivered to the Councillor Support Office on or before Friday, November 10. The External Relations and Protocol Office will contact each Council member assigned to place a wreath, and will provide additional information and contact details for the ceremonies.

If you are not assigned to place a wreath at one of these ceremonies, you are welcome to attend any of the ceremonies in Vancouver as a guest.

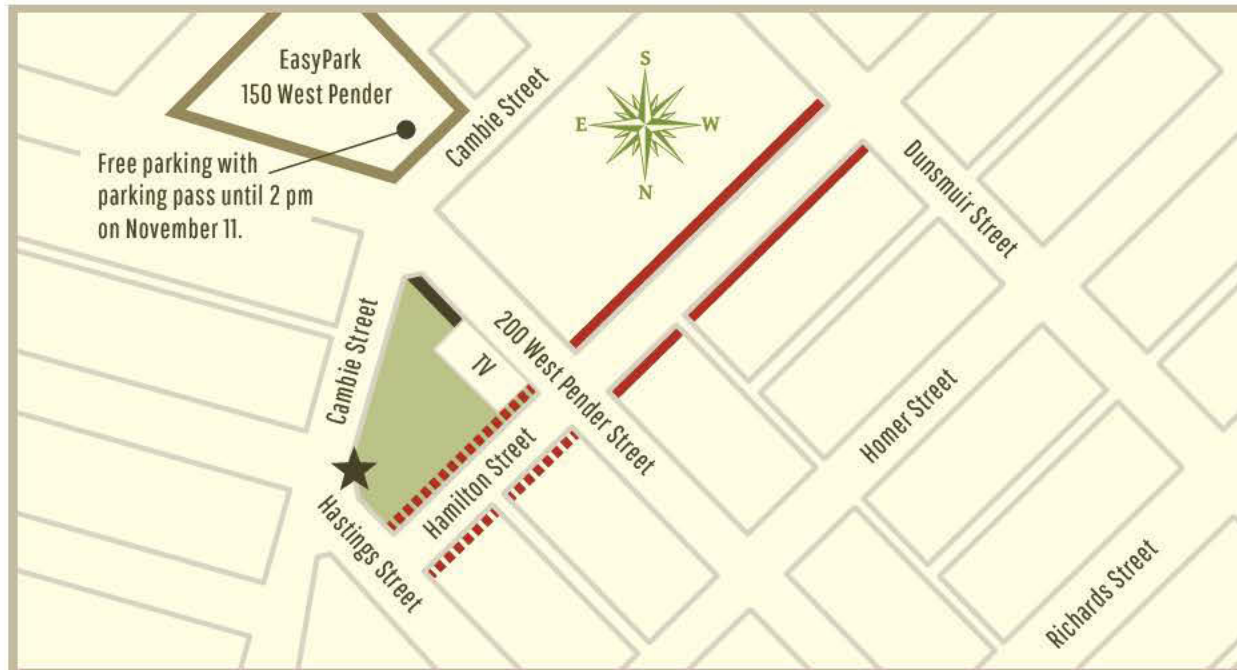

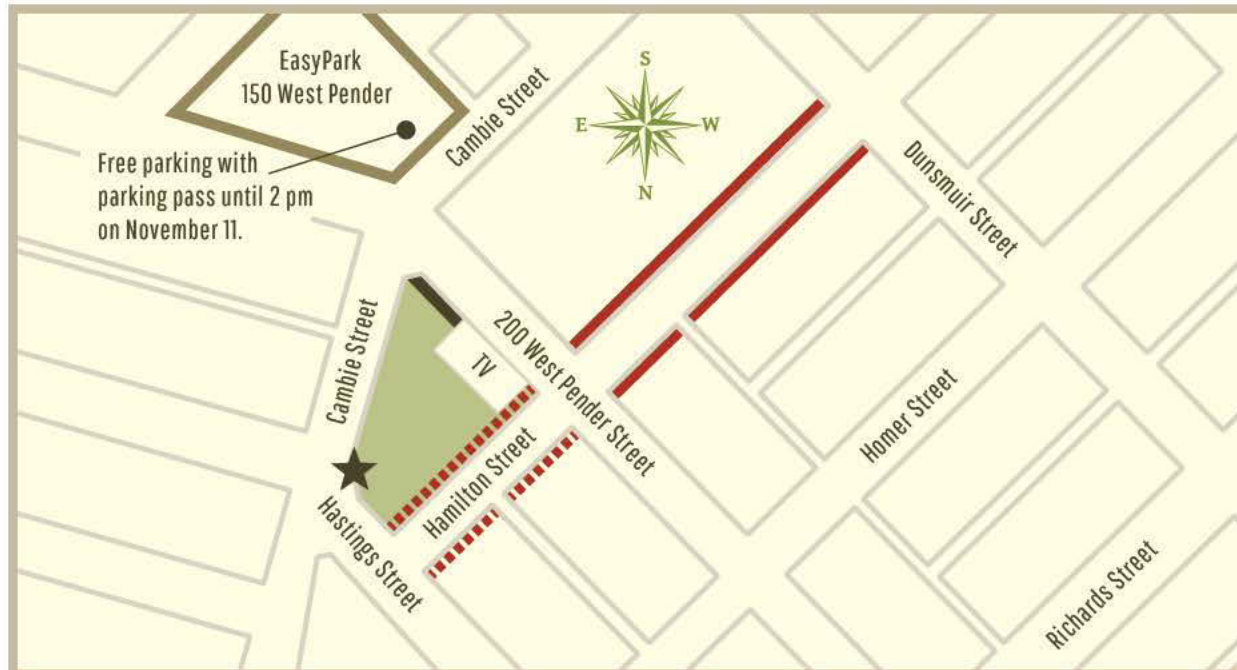
