About the project:

Vancouver is the first city in Canada and second in North America to introduce an electric fire truck to its fleet. This fire truck will bring many health and safety benefits to our firefighters, such as eliminating the risks of exposure to carcinogens and pollutants from diesel exhaust. The truck is also part of the City's effort to electrify its fleet to cut Vancouver's overall carbon pollution in half by 2030.

Limited parking will be available on site and a small number of street parking spots will also be available on Malkin Ave. This is an outdoor event and we advise attendees to dress accordingly.
