Location: 875 Terminal Avenue. Please note there is limited parking in the area.

The Tiny Shelters project provides vital shelter space to couples experiencing homelessness, an underserved group of people, including people who may not do well in a congregate setting. The project will be operated by Lu'ma who will also offer support services including showers, laundry, and community programming.

The Tiny Shelter Project is located adjacent to an active shelter. Please keep the privacy of individuals accessing the shelter in mind when touring the space or when taking photographs or videos.
