Dear Mayor and Council,

Please see the attached Memo from Lon LaClaire regarding **Hastings Sunrise (Clinton Park Area) Traffic Calming Engagement**. A short summary of the memo is as follows:

- Following the Strathcona and Hastings-Sunrise (Adanac Overpass) Neighbourhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) pilot projects, **Hastings-Sunrise (Clinton Park Area)** is first neighbourhood selected through the NTMP selection framework for traffic calming.
- The program aims to address vehicle speeds and volumes on local streets through quick-build measures.
- From **November 29 – December 17, 2023**, we are inviting residents to participate in a one-phase engagement process. In the engagement phase, staff will share data on vehicle speed and volume on local streets, confirm traffic issues with the community and ask questions about potential traffic calming measures to address various issues.
- Staff anticipate analysing feedback and refining traffic calming measures in Q1 and Q2 of 2024, and aim to begin implementation by fall 2024.

This memo provides an overview of upcoming stakeholder and public engagement in the Hastings-Sunrise (Clinton Park) area (formerly referred to as the Renfrew NW neighbourhood) as part of the Neighbourhood Traffic Management Program.

Neighbourhood Traffic Management Program

Hastings-Sunrise (Clinton Park Area) project is bounded by E Hastings St, Renfrew St, E 1st Av, and Nanaimo St, and is primarily a residential neighbourhood. Clinton Park will be the third project in the City's refreshed Neighbourhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP). See Appendix A for a map of the project area.

The NTMP supports traffic calming on a neighbourhood scale. The NTMP aims to address vehicle speeds and volumes on local streets through quick-build measures that improve safety and comfort for people walking, cycling and living in the area. Staff shared an update on the program with Council in June 2022 [Memo](#). In 2022, staff completed engagement for Strathcona, the first of two NTMP pilots. In 2023, three traffic calming measures were implemented in Strathcona, and additional measures are anticipated to be completed in 2024. In the summer of 2023, staff completed engagement for the second pilot project in Hastings-Sunrise (Adanac

Overpass). Staff are analysing the feedback and will share phase two engagement findings with the community in early 2024. Traffic calming implementation is planned to begin in 2024.

Hastings-Sunrise (Clinton Park Area) Traffic Calming

The Hastings-Sunrise (Clinton Park Area) project was prioritized based on the Neighbourhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) selection framework. The first stage of the NTMP framework assesses and scores all neighbourhoods across the City on key criteria. The 10 highest-scoring neighbourhoods then undergo a second stage of analysis to determine which neighbourhoods are a priority. The Clinton Park area scores high on the Disproportionately Impacted Communities map and there are opportunities to enhance future greenways with this work.

Community Engagement

In late November 2023, City staff will share data on vehicle speed and volume on local streets, confirm traffic issues with the community and ask questions about potential traffic calming measures to address various issues.

Between November 29 – December 17, 2023 staff will host two community pop-up events, a virtual workshop, and stakeholder meetings for area schools and other institutions. An online survey will also be available on Shape Your City and social media. Residents and businesses in the area will receive a notification letter in the mail detailing the date, time and how to participate in the workshops or share feedback online (please refer to Appendix B for the notification letter).

Next Steps

Once feedback is collected and analyzed in Q1 of 2024, staff will refine the traffic calming measures and aim to begin implementation by fall 2024.

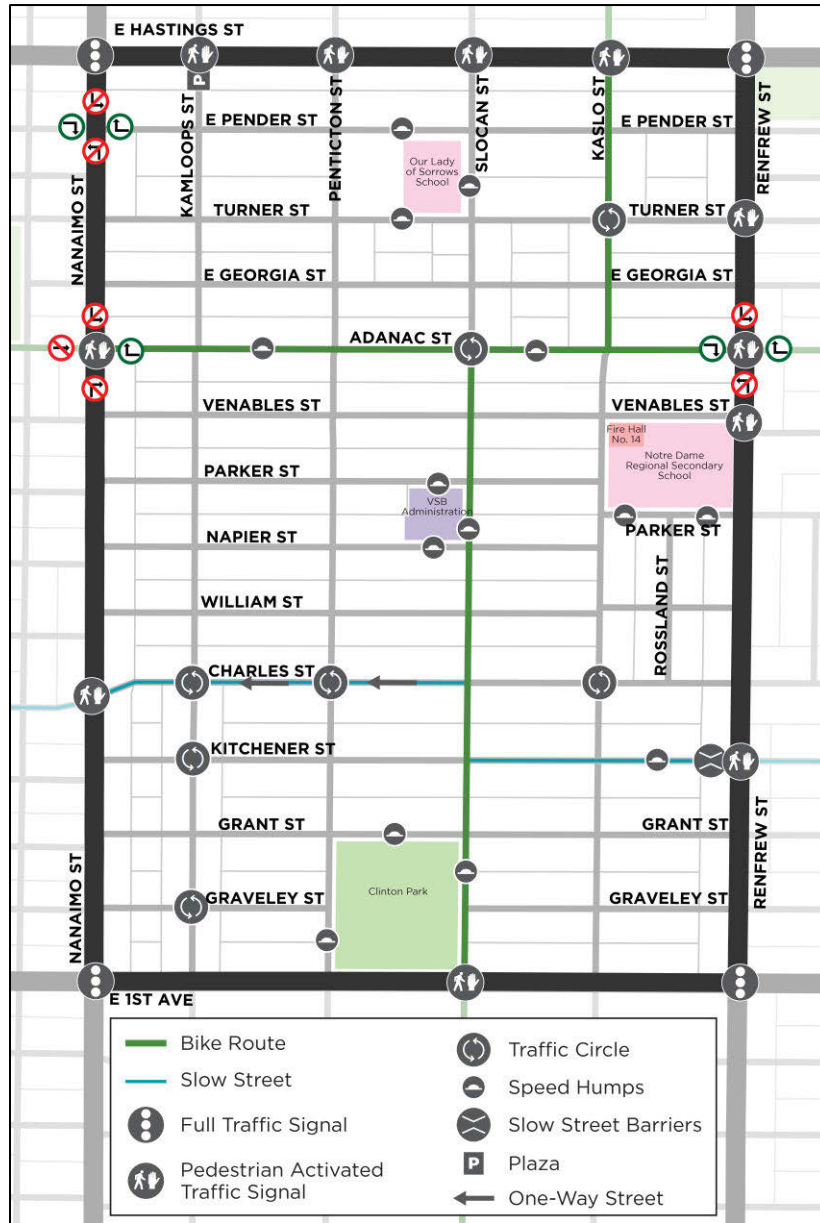

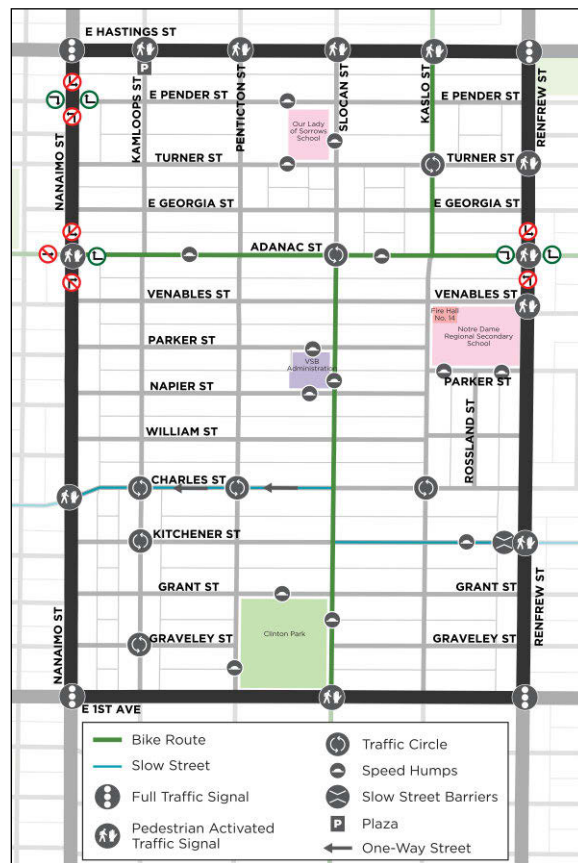
