Re: **Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")**

I am responding to your request of April 6, 2023 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Records from Streets and Transportation, Communications, and the City Manager's Office (such as emails, reports, briefing notes, memos, text messages, calendar invites, recorded meetings, and phone calls) discussing: 1) the traffic camera outages at Main and Hastings; and 2) how the cameras were going to be restored. Records to include emails generated as a result of external media requests about the traffic cameras. Date range: April 3, 2023 to April 5, 2023.

All responsive records are attached. Some information in the records has been severed (blacked out) under s.15(1)(l) of the Act. You can read or download this section here: http://www.bclaws.ca/EPLibraries/bclaws_new/document/ID/freeside/96165_00.

Just checking to see what the plan is in the event activists supply people with new tents to set up on Hastings Street after the decampment? How will the city keep Hastings clear of new tents and structures?

This may happen and crews will be connecting with people in any structures set up to ensure the structures are taken down as per the Fire Chief's Order and the by-law. The City and BC Housing continue to work with our partners on a variety of options to meet the needs of individuals experiencing homelessness in Vancouver, including longer term options, such as the expedited creation of more social and supportive housing.

To prevent re-establishment of structures in the short-term, VPD and crews will deploy quick response teams (QRTs) to remove structures at a smaller scale under the authority of the Street and Traffic by-law and the Fire Chief's Order.
