





There are spaces that have been reserved at one shelter for individuals who are currently staying outside on Hastings Street; they are accessed through direct referral from the City's Outreach team. Individuals who are staying in a shelter with reserved beds may stay for a short or long time. Individuals may leave a shelter due to receiving housing, returning to unsheltered homelessness, or many other reasons. There are plans to increase shelter capacity.

152 Accepted\* (Aug 17- March 28) This data represents the total number of people who have been connected to a shelter space. Outreach staff contact the shelter, reserve a bed for individuals, and support individuals with intake at the shelter. Individual stays or length of stay are not tracked by City Outreach staff. While a cumulative number is reported, it does not necessarily reflect the number of people currently staying in shelter as people may leave or transition out of shelter.





# Current State: Engineering

Prior to 2012, Urban issues work was originally allocated to the Street Operations branch

As the problem of structures and encampments grew within the City, the Sanitation Operations branch was called in to offer additional support and resources

Today, two teams within Engineering Services respond to Urban issues work in different ways

## **Street Operations:**

- Structure removal only
- Use pick-up trucks (requires multiple trips)
- Shifts: M-F and weekend OT
- Downtown Parks and locations City-wide (except Viaducts)
- Urban issues program budget and cost tracking / reporting

## Sanitation Operations:

- · Structure removal and site clean-up
- Use large capacity garbage trucks (less trips = more time in the field)
- · Shifts: Weekends only. No OT charged.
- Hastings and Viaducts only

Dear Meghan, Dale, Heidi, Allison, and Caitlin,

Yesterday and today, we have heard some information from within the encampment zone that indicates that there is some awareness of our planned schedule. VPD is assessing the situation and it is possible that we may need to adjust our schedule for moving to address the high risk sites. Accordingly, timing for when we move to this next phase is now uncertain, although we still recognize the high public and staff safety risk combined with the accelerating regrowth of the encampment necessitates timely action.

For now, we would request that BC Housing continue to accelerate work to ready rooms, seek to identify and plan to hold as many shelter spaces vacant as possible, and activate the EWR spaces if feasible so we are ready with sufficient shelter spaces when we need to advance to the next phase given the continued urgency to bring the encampment to a close. As well, Homelessness Services staff will continue to share information about people in the encampment by name with BC Housing and SDPR to support ongoing work and to ensure readiness for when we move to the next phase.

As requested, I have also scheduled us some time tomorrow afternoon that I hope works for you.

Thanks for the meeting as a summary, National Yards has two existing containers that were originally setup to support BCP, they are not being maintained or used at this time. To support VEMA and those who are Disproportionately Impacted by Emergencies VEMA requires a new site location with specific supplies / equipment to support the DTES within a secured city site that is within close proximity to the DTES. National yards is able to support the need with one of the existing containers.



Thank you for filling in the guard request form. Can you provide me with the Work Order # once it is available as I will need this to schedule the guard booking.

I visited the site s.15(1)(I) Street) yesterday for an assessment, and noted some risk/vulnerabilities with the chain link perimeter fencing on the east side of the site where sections of the barb wire is missing. As I was only able to review from the exterior, it couldn't be determined if there is any exis ng breaches within that fence line. There is an encampment set up outside of the fence line on the east side of the site. There appears to have been some target hardening in one section of the chain link fence on the east side which may have resulted from a past breach? Would recommend as a long term measure based on risk and future use of the site (if valued assets will continue to be stored here) to implement target hardening improvements throughout the perimeter fence line starting with the east side. Will ensure the guards that are booked for this assignment has a heighten since of focus on this area in the meantime.

In terms of access to the site, can keys to the vehicular gate entrance off prior street and the pedestrian door off prior street be provided.
