I hope you are well and I want to thank you again for bringing together the VPD Lion Dance team and your sister club to perform at Monday's ceremony. I have three quick questions for you that I am hoping you can answer as soon as possible:

2. I was speaking with the Civic Theatres staff today. We can either provide a green room on the 4th floor of the Orpheum or in one of the green rooms at back of stage.
