Good evening Mayor and Council,

Thank you for your patience with information responses today with regard to our cold weather response for people without housing. There are a number of updates from the ACCS team below.

#### Activations: January 12-15

First, please find attached a list of open Emergency Weather Response (EWR) and Warming Centres in Vancouver for the nights of January 12-15 (inclusive) and the City of Vancouver Shelter Postcard. Important Updates:

- Kiwassa Neighbourhood House EWR (2425 Oxford Street) and Commercial Hastings EWR (1726 East Hastings Street) are now open.
- The Nest (320 Alexandar Street) is open 24 hours on Friday the 12<sup>th</sup>, Saturday the 13<sup>th</sup>, and Sunday the 14<sup>th</sup>
- ullet Carnegie Community Centre will open at 7am on Friday the 12<sup>th</sup>, Saturday the 13<sup>th</sup>, Sunday the 14<sup>th</sup>, and Monday the 15<sup>th</sup>
- West End Community Centre will open 9pm to 6am on Friday the 12<sup>th</sup>, 5pm to 6am on Saturday the 13<sup>th</sup> , and 5pm to 6am on Sunday the 14<sup>th</sup>

#### **Notable Changes**

We would like to express our appreciation to Recreation team for their work to extend hours at WECC and Creekside so that they open earlier so that the Warming Centres open once the Centres close. In addition to the Homelessness Services Warming Centre team, all of these extensions above are made possible because existing operational staff agreed to work additional hours to enable the facilities to be open when they would normally close.

#### **WECC**

Friday: opening 9pm (originally 11pm)
Saturday: opening 5pm (originally 11pm)
Sunday: opening 5pm (originally 11pm)

#### Creekside:

Friday: opening 8:30pm (originally 1030pm)

Carnegie Community Centre has also been able to extend their 7am opening through to Tuesday, Jan 16th.

#### Communications Update

- City communications have been updated to remind people that public libraries and community centres welcome people to come inside to be warm during the day.
  - Park Board have clarified for facility staff that patrons can use the community centre as place to stay warm during facility hours (and warming centre hours).
- Social media plan has been developed to inform the public of daytime warming areas (VPL, Social Operations, and Community Centres during operating hours). Regular posts will go out from Friday to Sunday
- A print poster with a map has been created to use at Community Centres and other locations to remind the public of daytime warming areas

#### Utilization: January 11

#### Please Note:

- Warming Centres generally do not have the same capacity issues as shelters because they do not provide beds or mats like shelters do. People come and go as they please and the goal is to accommodate everyone.
- The only event where someone is asked to leave is for a violent incident.
- Of note, OPS was not able to accommodate a max of 30 people on Jan 11 due to staff capacity, but they are referred to other Warming Centres and EWRs in the neighbourhood. Fortunately, there are a number of options in the DTES between the Nest, AFD, PSG and Chinatown Peace Church.
