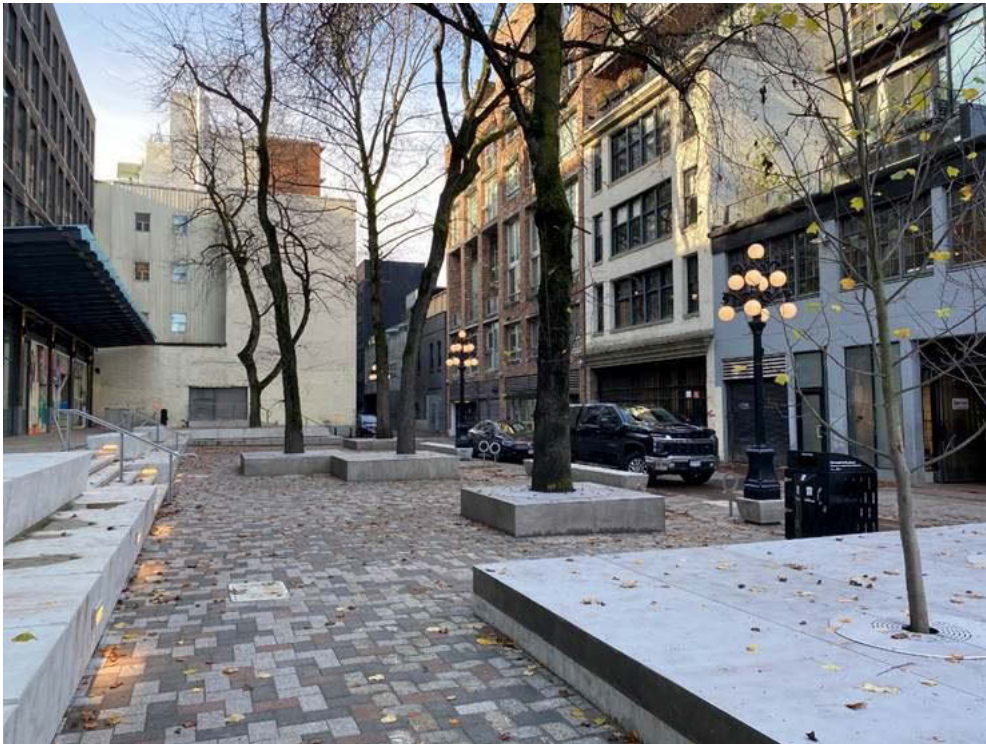

Subject: Blood Alley Square - Construction Completion

Dear Mayor and Council,

This email provides a brief update on the Blood Alley Square Redesign project. The construction for Blood Alley Square is complete and the square is open to the public. Additionally, targeted interim asphalt repairs were done in Trounce Alley to patch key areas, with permanent restoration for Trounce Alley adjacent to the Square planned for Spring 2025.

The newly constructed Blood Alley Square features: heritage defining elements (globe lighting, stone pavers, and re-used cobble & brick – see below image), permeable paving for rainwater management, a performance stage for local arts, fixed seating, 5 retained mature trees, 2 new trees, and a shared community loading zone.



A stewardship plan for Blood Alley Square has been created in collaboration with community partners. This plan will guide the daily management, maintenance, and programming of the Square, and will continue to evolve over time. Community events and programming have already started in the Square.
