Subject: Public Hearing schedule

Good morning Mayor and Council,

I am writing to let you know that the City Clerk's team will be cancelling the Public Hearings scheduled for April 11, April 25 and May 9. The Public Hearings scheduled for April 9 and May 7 will proceed as scheduled and we will hold the April 11 and May 9 times as reserve dates to conclude any business outstanding from those hearings.

We are currently seeing a reduction in the number of projects reaching the Public Hearing stage in the near term; this trend reflects the decrease in rezoning applications submitted over the first half of 2023.

Rezoning submissions increased in the later months of 2023 and we anticipate that Public Hearing volumes will return to more typical volumes (6-8 files per hearing) over the course of this year. We also anticipate increased applications associated with the significant number of rezoning enquiries received following approval of the Broadway Plan.
