Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of January 11, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Record of budget (broken down by year) regarding the placement of sandbags at Locarno Beach for the winter high tides. Date range: January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2023.

Further to our initial response to you on February 12, 2024, our office has conducted a due diligence search for records responsive to your request. Engineering Services has provided the following information in response to your request:

Engineering Services staff have confirmed that the above-noted costs reflect the annual costs for the program. No budget is assigned for the work involving sandbag placement at Locarno Beach for the winter high tides.
