Subject:	Planetarium leak repair update

Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

Some of you may have received a reach out from the ED of the HR MaMillan Space Centre expressing concern about a delay in water pipe repairs. Please see below for a brief summary from Facilities Management and Operational Excellence (FMOE):

- Approximately a week ago, bubbling water was observed, indicating a broken water line.
- The water line leads into and serves the whole cultural complex, which includes the Space Centre/Planetarium, MOV & the Archives.
- FMOE immediately enlisted the Engineering Water Works team and after significant investigation, they found a break buried under a magnolia tree in the garden.
- The repair was initially scheduled for today, and the cultural campus tenants were notified of the scheduled repair.
- While preparing a 12 feet excavation for the repair, the team were faced with unexpected water flow and slumping sides. The work had to pause while the shoring was reinforced for worker safety. This required reinforcement work, unfortunately, caused a delay in the overall repair schedule by one day.
- The final repair has been rescheduled for tomorrow morning at 8:00 a.m. In the meantime, FMOE is arranging for porta-potties to allow the buildings to remain open for tomorrow until the repair is complete.

We understand HRMSC's frustration given the impact on venue operations, but it is difficult to predict all site variables and we cannot proceed with work in unsafe conditions. I assure you that FMOE staff understand the importance of timely response and they are in regular contact with the management teams of the various site tenants.
