Good afternoon Sarah,

I can provide the following update on the situation at City Hall:

- , City Protective Services observed a minivan engulfed in flames. Vehicle was on the driveway outside the South entrance of City Hall
- The driver sat on the ground near the vehicle until VPD arrived. After admitting that he had set his own vehicle on fire deliberately, VPD arrested the driver. The driver left a manifesto on the ground, which City Protective Services has collected and TMU will be advised.
- No persons injured
- The driver's intentions are unknown at this time, pending VPD investigation. Additional security being arranged to watch over City Hall perimeter over night.
- 12th Avenue between Yukon and Cambie have been closed off.
- Fire has been extinguished by VFRS. Vehicle is still on scene.
- VFRS and VPD still on-site investigating
- Multiple media personnel on site
- City Hall closed per normal Sunday hours so no direct impact to operations.
- City Protective Services currently assisting VPD and VFRS with investigations.

We will keep you apprised of any further developments.
