Subject: Administrative Error in Metro Appointments

Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

A resolution passed by Council at the Council Meeting following the Standing Committee on Policy and Strategic Priorities on October 23, 2024 had an administrative error with respect to the Metro appointments. The City of Vancouver has 34 votes, while the resolution that was approved by Council totalled 35 votes as follows:

G. THAT Council approve the following Appointment of Council Representative to Regional Bodies for the term November 1, 2024, to November 2, 2026:

In order to correct this administrative error, it is recommended that Councillor Meiszner, who replaced Councillor Carr as a Director, be allocated the votes previously assigned to Councillor Carr (4 votes).

The City Clerk will prepare a Communication to be included on the November 12, 2024 Council meeting agenda that will explain this administrative error and recommend an amendment to the previously adopted resolution. In order to consider this amendment, a member who voted with the majority on this resolution on October 23, 2024 would need to move the motion, in accordance with section 8.13(4)(b) of the Procedure By-law. The language for the amendment will be provided in the Communication from the City Clerk.

Staff have spoken with the Corporate Officer at Metro Vancouver and because Vancouver cannot be allocated more votes than allowed, they will treat Councillor Meiszner as a replacement for Councillor Carr and allocate him 4 votes for tomorrow's meetings, in absence of a revised Council resolution.
