The purpose of this memo is to update Council on changes to the Women4Climate (W4C) Mentorship Program and to announce the recruitment period for the 2025 cohort.

Between 2019 and 2023, the City of Vancouver delivered the C40 Cities W4C Mentorship Program in Vancouver in partnership with the Zero Emissions Building Exchange (2019-2022) and the Zero Emissions Innovation Centre (2022-2023). Over those four years, the C40 W4C Program educated and empowered more than 40 local women working on community-based climate solutions that contributed to Vancouver's Climate Emergency Action Plan and/or Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and engaged dozens of women leaders from across sectors as mentors. As communicated to Council in May 2024, C40 Cities made the decision earlier this year to retire the global W4C Program and extended the opportunity for the Program to be assumed locally, using the W4C name and branding. Throughout 2024, staff have been working with the local non-profit Zero Emissions Innovation Centre (ZEIC) to enable them to take the lead on delivering a reimagined, regional W4C Program.

The transition of the program is now complete: this month ZEIC will launch a W4C Program to serve the Metro Vancouver region. The Program will continue to build the next generation of women climate leaders (including marginalized genders like trans women, non binary people, and 2 Spirit) by matching emerging leaders with senior-level women from government, business, and community organizations. The Program will include a new leadership training component made possible through an exciting partnership with <u>Academy for Sustainable Innovation</u>. The call for applications for the 2025 W4C cohort runs from November 21, 2024 to January 16, 2025. Details can be found at <u>Women for Climate - ZEIC</u>.
