Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of March 5, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act f*or:

Regarding the City of Vancouver FIFA Secretariat, record of the full names and titles of the nine full-time staff and two full-time contractors, and their annual salary or maximum value of their contract.

All responsive information has been provided below\*. Please note, in addition to the responsive information, the City Manager's Office has provided additional information for clarity.

The FWC26 Secretariat is structured as a project rather than a department. This means that staff are assigned to this work, while they remain in their home department within the City, the Board of Parks and Recreation, the Vancouver Police Department, and/or the Vancouver Public Library. Some of these staff positions are working on the FWC26 event planning and delivery full-time, while others are doing so part-time. Further, each staff member is working on this project for a specified period of time – this period of time may be a few months or up to approximately four years.

This is a list of the key staff who are currently working on FWC26 planning and delivery, and as we get closer to the event, the number of City staff working on this file will increase.
