Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of March 10, 2024 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Record of pesticide with active ingredient glyphosate ("Roundup") being sprayed in or near Stanley Park, including:

- 1. Schedule of use;**
- 2. Treatment areas;**
- 3. Date and time of usage;**
- 4. Company name using the pesticide;**
- 5. Contact information of company; and**
- 6. Contract and licence details (including which pest is being controlled).**

Date range: January 1, 2017 to March 10, 2024.

All responsive records are attached. Please note that Park Board Staff have confirmed there was no contract for this work.
